

On January 1, 2022, a new scoring system was institutionalized for Step 1 reporting system. Being the only objective method for residency distinction based on academic performance, Step 2 CK score has become an important metric that residency directors now use to quickly evaluate and filter the number of program applicants. This new system of assessing applicants' performance based on numerical score is still the same, the only difference is transition from step 1 score to step 2 score.

Results

What is an impressive step 2 Ck score; Data provided by the National Board of Medical Examiners, which administers the USMLE, indicate that the average score for Step 2 CK for U.S. medical graduates' and IMGs hovers just above 240. Although, it's been 242 to 243 over the past few years. The 25th percentile is around 232, while the 75th percentile is near 256. The implication of these percentiles is that if your score is at or below 232, you're in the bottom 1/4 of test takers, while if you score at or above 256, you're in the top 1/4. If you score 243, you're right in the middle of the pack. The 2020 report by the National Resident Matching Program (NRMP) showed a mean (average) Step 2 CK score of 246.9 for students who matched to their first-choice specialty.
